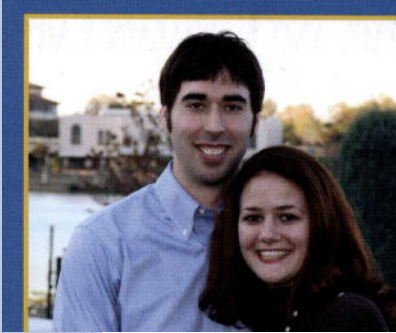


## Soldiers for Christ. . Church planting in Nagoya, Japan



**Michael and Cathalain Carter** will be our guests during our Christian Education hour on February 22<sup>nd</sup>. While Michael served as an intern in Chiba, Japan, God revealed to him the need for the gospel in this nation where many have never heard the message before. His heart for the Japanese led to a desire to do long-term ministry in Japan.

For two years, Cathalain's family was stationed in Japan. She was exposed to the Japanese culture by living off base and attending a Japanese school. Although Cathalain was young, this experience shaped her love for other cultures.

Michael and Cathalain met in Virginia and were married in May 2007. Together they shared a heart for the Japanese and have been called to serve the Lord on the church-planting team in Nagoya, Japan, where there is only one church for every 26,000 people.

Michael will teach English classes as well as lead evangelistic Bible studies. Cathalain will teach at the International Christian Academy. Both will be involved in ministry and discipleship to college students. Please pray that God will bless the team's work in Nagoya and pray for many to know Him through the mission's work. They are currently raising support and plan to be in Nagoya in the fall of 2009.
