Astoria is a community of people from over 125 different countries. The cultural diversity you experience in the variety of shops, parks and people is incomparable to any other community it's size.

A one week intensive English class brought people from Peru, Columbia, Spain, Russia, Turkey, Korea, Mexico, Brazil, and Macedonia to Astoria Community Church from July 12-16.
